**Indigenous Legacy Item
Atrium Area**

Justice Institute of British Columbia (JIBC) continues to engage in a process of Indigenization for our campuses. JIBC's New Westminster campus is located on the traditional, unceded territories of the Qayqayt and Musqueam Nations. In order to better reflect the Indigenous students and communities in which we serve and work, JIBC is seeking an Indigenous artist to design and complete a Legacy Item to be displayed in the Atrium area of the New Westminster campus. A Legacy Item is considered a work such as a Welcome Post/Pole or Canoe. The maximum height for the Legacy Item is 20 feet with a maximum diameter base of 5 feet.

This request is issued for Indigenous artists to submit a brief expression of interest to be considered for selection to submit a more detailed proposal and cost in the second phase of this proposal. In the first phase, we request a description of similar past experience, with photos and references. Three parties will then be requested to submit a sketch or maquette, a written description, a price, and a schedule to produce their proposed work. All Legacy Item ideas will be considered.

An Indigenous led selection committee will then review the submissions and make the decision as to which work will be selected. Note: the preparation for the work will require a site visit.

All work purchased will become the property of JIBC and will give recognition by naming the artist. Proposed work not commissioned at this time may be commissioned later when additional funding is obtained. Further information about JIBC can be found on our [website](#).

Interested parties are requested to submit a written *Expression of Interest* containing detailed information on similar work experience including photographs, capacity and references. Furthermore, please include an artist bio.

Expressions of Interest should be signed, completed and received by appointment at the Justice Institute of British Columbia prior to the closing date. Electronic submissions are preferred at this time.
