Responsibilities

- Complete task hazard assessments and maintain a safe work environment.
- Inspect equipment prior to operating, and document.
- Operate Crane/ Boom- complete weight calculations to ensure proper capacity
- Must report any unsafe conditions, incidents or near misses.

- Experience working in Bridge construction considered an asset.
- Must hold valid Crane operator ticket or show apprenticeship certification.

- Understanding and the ability to follow safe work procedures and work within a crew accordingly.
